Re: **AESO 2007 GTA (Application No. 1485517)**
AESO Revised Responses to Information Requests

The Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) herewith files revised responses to those information requests (IRs) identified in its letter dated February 5, 2007 in response to the motions filed by intervenors regarding the adequacy of certain of the AESO's original responses. Revised responses to the following IRs have been submitted via the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (EUB) Digital Data Submission system:

- EnCana.AESO-018 (b)
- IPCAA.AESO-009 (d)
- IPCAA.AESO-009 (e)
- TCE.AESO-003 (e)
- TCE.AESO-016 (a)
- TCE.AESO-024 (b)
- TCE.AESO-033 (d)
- TCE.AESO-036 (a)

The AESO has been unable to fully complete a revised response to TCE.AESO-004 (a-c) at this time. We will provide that revised response as soon as possible.

The EUB has also asked for an indication of the time and effort required to compile aggregate hourly load data for individual PODs in response to IPCAA.AESO-047 (c). The AESO notes that IPCAA indicated in its reply to the AESO response to motions that IPCAA is prepared to accept aggregate data for loads at the 64 substations referenced in the AESO's response to IPCAA.AESO-047 (b). The AESO estimates that providing that data would require the following time and effort:

- one to three weeks for IT resources to become available,
- one to two days to build and test a query to extract the data,
- about 12 hours of actual run time to generate the data (expected to total about 100 MB), and
- one to two days to aggregate the data in the manner requested and verify the final data set.
