**Re: Technical Meeting for AESO 2008 Deferral Account Reconciliation Application

The AESO filed its 2008 Deferral Account Reconciliation Application (Application No. 1604964) with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) on April 9, 2009, and posted it on the AESO website the same day. As participants appeared to find the technical meetings on prior deferral account reconciliation applications to be worthwhile, the AESO has scheduled a technical meeting on the 2008 application for the afternoon of May 4, 2009, at the AESO's office in downtown Calgary. Please note that this meeting is intended primarily for participants who will be registering in the AESO's 2008 Deferral Account Reconciliation Application proceeding, although other interested parties may attend. The AESO expects that much of the material presented at the meeting will be similar to that presented at the deferral account reconciliation consultation meeting held on March 3, 2009, although final amounts as filed in the application will be discussed. The technical meeting will address the following topics:

- brief review of the contents of the application,
- determination of annual deferral account balances,
- explanation of customer allocation methodology, and
- review of reports included as appendices to the application.

Attendees at the meeting are expected to have reviewed and be familiar with the contents of the AESO's application.

Customers of the AESO should also have received by email information on the customer numbers assigned to their accounts in the appendices to the 2008 Deferral Account Reconciliation Application, as well as information on how to request additional deferral account reconciliation and allocation data by transmission settlement point. As that data represents confidential customer information, the AESO does not expect to discuss such information at the technical meeting.
