Re: Letter of Notice – Proposed Level I Removal of OPP 808 Sabotage Reporting (“OPP 808 Removal”)

Pursuant to Section 2(1) of the Alberta Utilities Commission (“Commission”) Rule 017, the Alberta Electric System Operator (“AESO”) is providing notice and seeking feedback on the proposed OPP Removal. [Click here](#) to view a copy of OPP 808 being proposed for removal.

Transition of Authoritative Documents (“TOAD”) Reforms

The OPP 808 Removal is the result of the specific TOAD project. Under TOAD the AESO is endeavoring to eliminate duplication, address conflicts and gaps and improve clarity among and within its three authoritative document domains: the ISO rules, the ISO tariff and the Alberta Reliability Standards. Elimination of Duplication in Alberta Reliability Standards

OPP 808 was reviewed in conjunction with Alberta Reliability Standard CIP-001-AB-1. It was determined the authoritative components of OPP 808 contained unnecessary duplication, and that the subject matter was appropriately and adequately contained in Alberta Reliability Standard CIP-001-AB-1. OPP 808 will be withdrawn in its entirety, leaving only Alberta Reliability Standard CIP-001-AB-1 as setting out the sabotage reporting requirements for market participants.

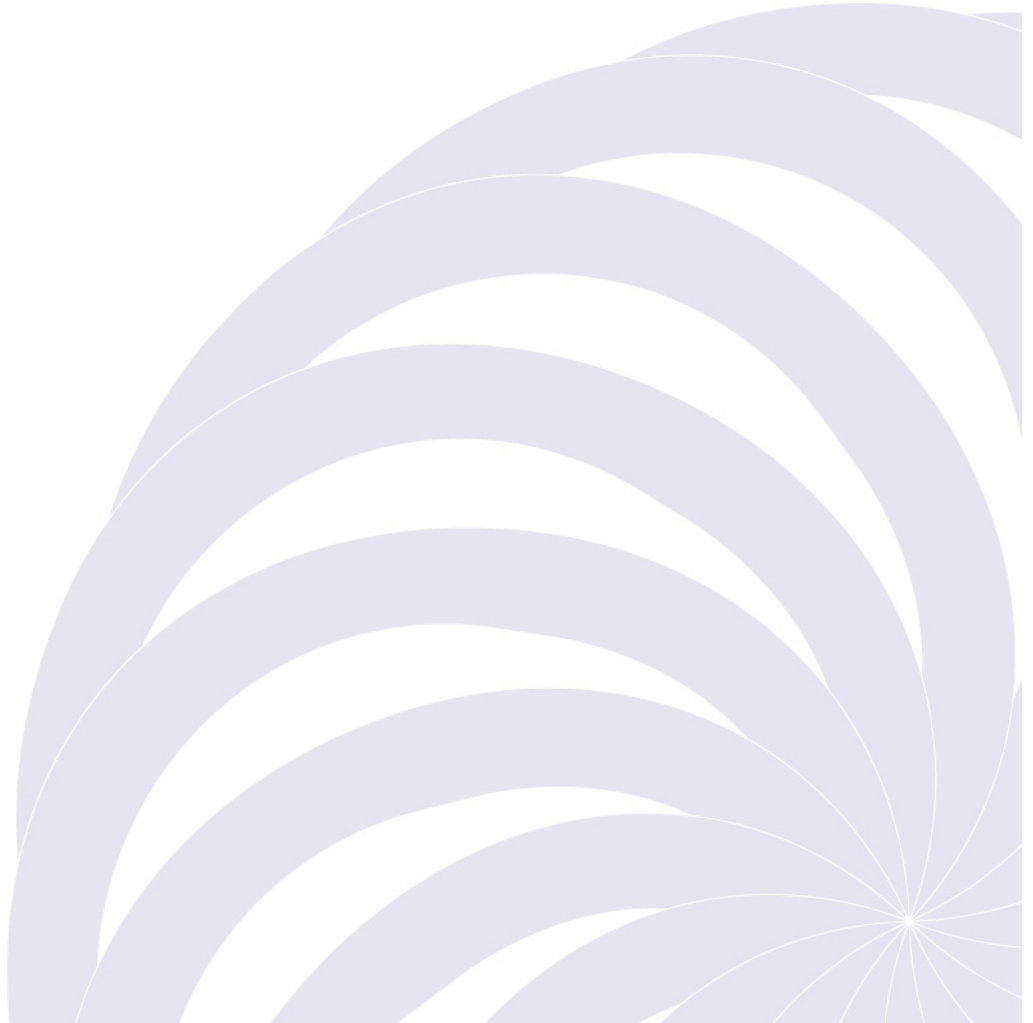

Proposed LEVEL II ISO Rule Changes

Level II changes are changes that are expected to have a moderate or low impact on the industry or the ISO, and generally require little or no effort by stakeholders for implementing a solution. They are provided to stakeholders to review to ensure that the expected impact is reasonable, to identify unrealized impacts and/or to provide notice of the potential change in administrative processes.

OPP 808 – Sabotage Reporting	
Rule Section/Number	Part 3, OPP 808 Sabotage Reporting
Summary of ISO Rule	OPP 808 sets out policies and defines responsibilities and procedures to identify and report sabotage and cyber sabotage incidents, confirmed or suspected, that could affect the operation of the Alberta Interconnected Electric System.
Reason for Removal	The AESO proposes to remove OPP 808 as the authoritative components of OPP 808 are appropriately contained in the Alberta Reliability Standard CIP-001-AB-1.
