Dear Market Participants and Interested Parties:

Re: AESO Reply to Stakeholder Comments – Proposed Changes to Existing ISO Rules:
a) 6.3.5 Long Lead Time Energy, and
b) 8.1.1 Settlement at Pool Price (consequential changes)
(collectively the “Proposed ISO Rules Changes”)

On July 8, 2010, the AESO issued a [Letter of Notice](#) setting out the Proposed ISO Rules Changes and requesting stakeholder comments on the same.

In accordance with Section 8 of Alberta Utilities Commission (“AUC” or Commission”) Rule 017, the Alberta Electric System Operator (“AESO”) is required to provide a reply to stakeholder comments received regarding the Proposed ISO Rules Changes. No written stakeholder comments were received by the AESO on the proposed ISO Rules Changes and Incidental Amendments to ISO Rules as set out in the AESO’s July 8, 2010 Letter of Notice.

The final Proposed ISO Rules Changes (the “Final Proposed ISO Rules Changes”) being recommended for internal AESO approval in August 2010 are also attached.

Filing of the Final Proposed ISO Rules Changes

The AESO is expecting to file the Final Proposed ISO Rules Changes with the Commission on September 13, 2010.

In accordance with Section 20.4 of the *Electric Utilities Act* (“EUA”), market participants, may object to an ISO rule filed with the Commission within 10 days of the publication by the Commission of the notice of filing of the ISO rule.

In accordance with Section 20.3 of the EUA, the Final Proposed ISO Rules Changes are proposed to become effective concurrently with the Commission approved effective date for the Final Proposed New ISO Rules 5 Provisions.
