Subject: Comments on Proposed ARS PRC-015

Jerry. We understand the comment period for proposed ARS PRC-015 has been extended to Aug. 10th. We would like to offer the following comment relative to R1 of the proposed standard:

Given the complexity of certain schemes and the significant work associated with review of detailed design / logic review and preparation of documentation that outlines scheme logic, ownership boundaries, communication paths etc., we suggest that a 180 day period is a more reasonable period of time to properly respond to any AESO request on any specific RAS. Too, for any AESO request of information on a relatively large number of legacy systems (particularly LAPS) in place on AE's system, we would also suggest requests be staggered accordingly to allow proper management of resources.

We would also like to mention that AE is currently focused on meeting ARS requirements for RAS classified as Alberta RAS recognizing the significance of these schemes to the AIS.
