Re: Notice of Filing – Proposed Amendments to the Interpretation Section of Alberta Reliability Standards (“Interpretation Section Changes”)

1. The Alberta Electric System Operator (“AESO”) is filing the attached Interpretation Section Changes pursuant to Section 19 of the *Transmission Regulation*.
2. The Interpretation Section Changes are administrative in nature and would be of interest to all market participants referencing the Alberta Reliability Standards.
