Dear Market Participants and Interested Parties:

Re: Amended Stakeholder Comments on Terms of Reference on proposed:

- a) **New ISO Rules Section 502.7 SCADA and Phasor Measurement Unit Technical Requirements** proposing to replace the AESO SCADA Standard and the AESO Phasor Measurement Unit Requirements standard (“New ISO Rules Section 502.7”);
- b) **Removal of Existing ISO OPP 003.1 Electric Facility Data and Communications for the Alberta Control Area;** and
- c) **Development of a proposed new Information Document supporting New ISO Rules Section 502.7 SCADA and Phasor Measurement Unit Technical Requirements.**

(collectively the “New ISO Rules Section 502.7 Changes”)

On January 19, 2012 the Alberta Electric System Operator (“AESO”) posted stakeholder comments received on the New ISO Rules Section 502.7 Changes and provided notice to market participants in our weekly stakeholder newsletter.
