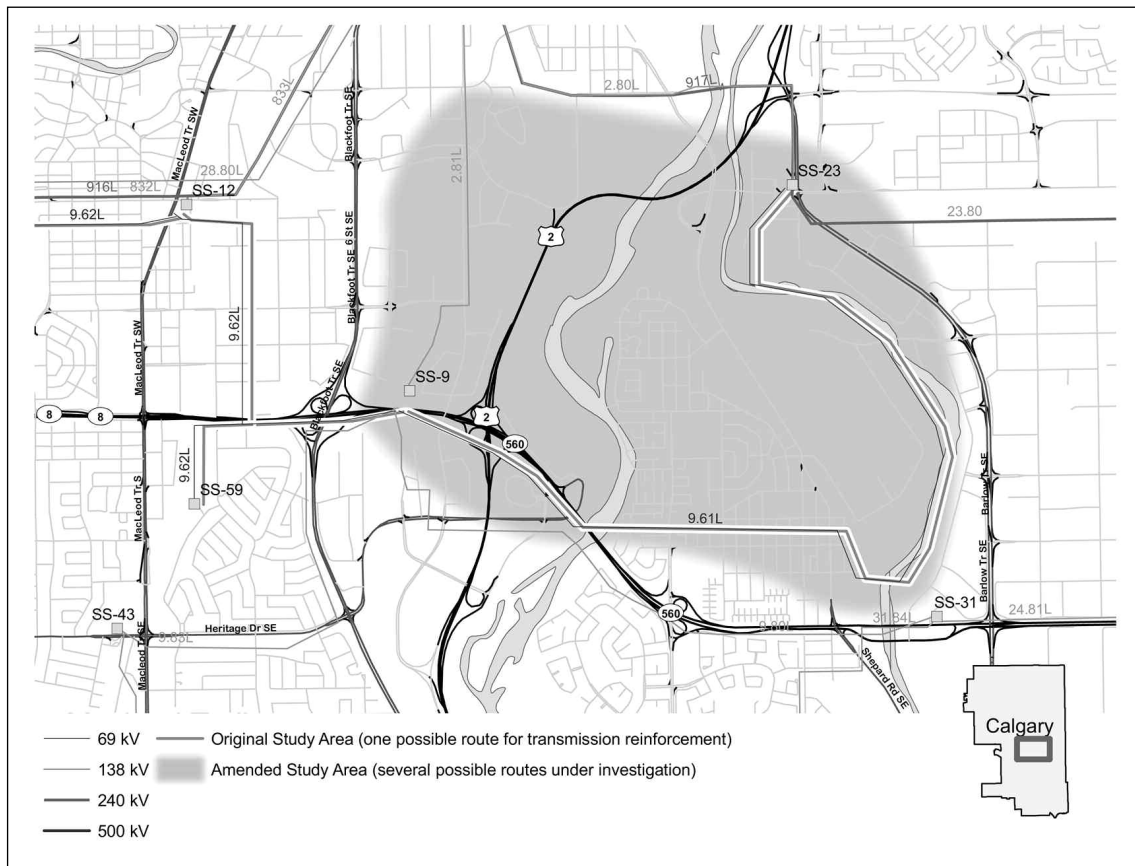


Notification of Regulatory Filing for Transmission System Reinforcement in south Calgary

The Alberta Electric System Operator advises you of its intention to file an amended Needs Identification Document with the Alberta Utilities Commission to upgrade the transmission system in south Calgary.

In April 2009, the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) filed a Needs Identification Document (NID) with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) to upgrade the 69 kV (69,000 volt) transmission system in south Calgary. The AESO is amending this NID (application #1604960) to allow Transmission Facility Owner (TFO) ENMAX Power Corporation to investigate alternate routing options for the southeast phase of this transmission development.




The map above shows the original area of possible transmission development in south Calgary, as well as a new transmission study area (shown as a grey shaded area) which captures new routing possibilities. The original route, shown as a solid grey line, remains an option.

The AESO mailed information about this amendment to residents in the study area and other stakeholders in December 2009, and also hosted an open house about the amendment earlier in January 2010. The AESO weighed insights gathered from stakeholders with technical and cost considerations and has decided to proceed with this amendment. The AESO will file an amended NID with the AUC by February 16, 2010. ENMAX Power Corporation will file a facilities application with the AUC to carry out this work.
