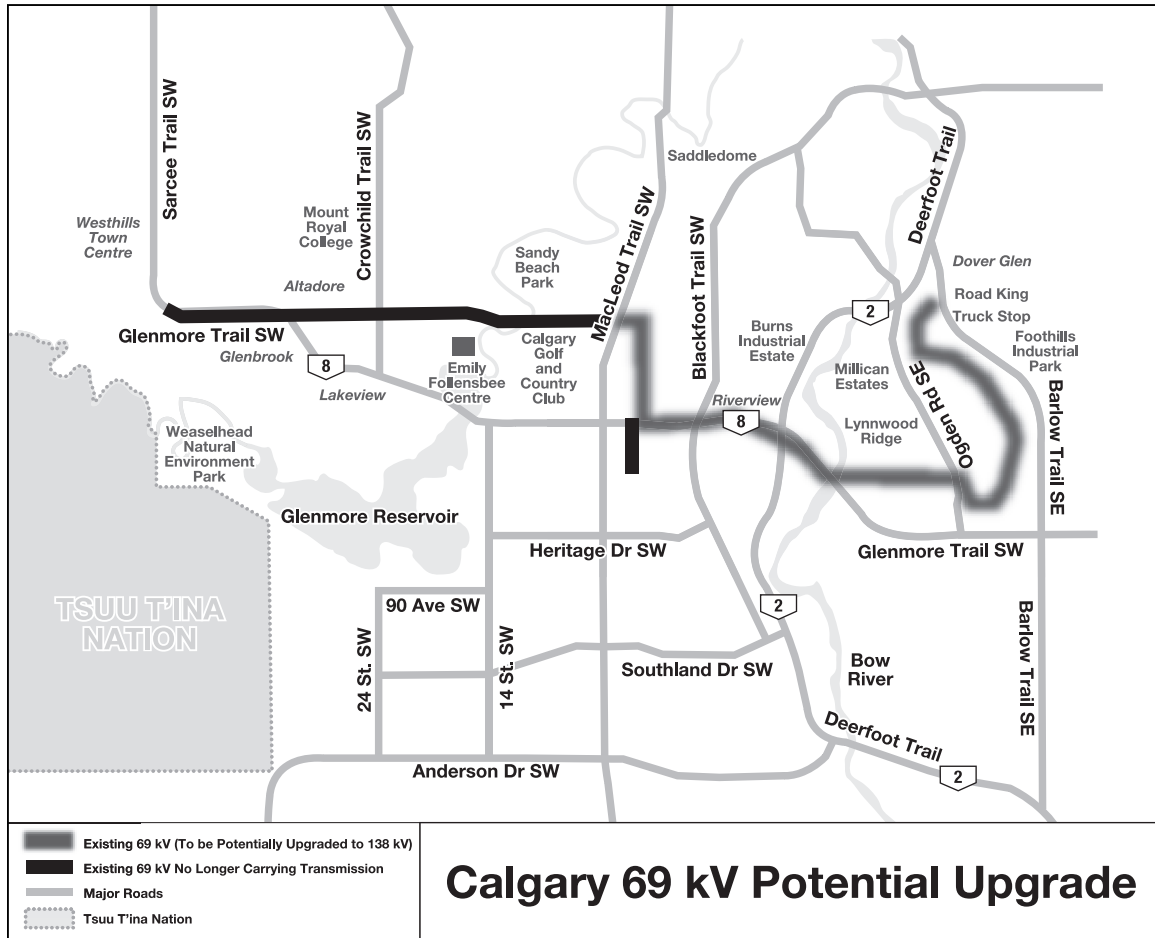


Notification of Regulatory Filing for Transmission System Reinforcement in South Calgary

The Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) advises you of its intention to file a needs application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) to upgrade an existing transmission line in south Calgary.

The AESO has identified the need to reinforce a section of the transmission system running through south Calgary, between Sarcee Trail in the southwest, and Ogden Road in the southeast. The map below shows the location of this potential reinforcement.



This section of the transmission system currently operates at a transmission capacity of 69 kV (69 000 volts), however, it is proposed to be upgraded to a capacity of 138 kV (138 000 volts). Aging equipment, increasing demand for power in the areas served by this section of the transmission system and the restoration of operational flexibility, account for this need.

The AESO and Transmission Facility Owner ENMAX presented this need to residents along this section of line and other stakeholders during a variety of consultation activities held in June, July and August of 2008. Transmission Facility Owner AltaLink also consulted on portions of this proposed work in February 2009 with AESO participation. The AESO weighed insights gathered from stakeholders with technical and cost considerations and has decided to apply to the AUC to have these transmission facilities upgraded. The AESO will file its application by April 9, 2009. ENMAX and AltaLink will also apply to the AUC to carry out this work.
