

Notification of Regulatory Filing for Transmission System Reinforcement in the Airdrie area

The Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) advises you of its intention to file a needs application with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) to upgrade existing transmission substations in the Airdrie area.

The 2009/2010 forecast for the City of Airdrie shows that the demand for electricity is growing faster than previously anticipated.

The Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) is recommending the addition of capacitor banks and related equipment to the existing East Airdrie and Dry Creek substations, to help maintain local voltage, and to meet the growing need for electricity in the Airdrie area. The maps below show the locations of this proposed transmission reinforcement.




The AESO and Transmission Facility Owner (TFO) AltaLink presented this need to residents near these substations and other stakeholders during a variety of consultation activities held in March and April of this year (2009). The AESO weighed insights gathered from stakeholders with technical and cost considerations, and has decided to apply to the AUC to have these transmission facilities upgraded. The AESO will file its needs application with the AUC by July 10, 2009. AltaLink will also file facilities applications with the AUC to carry out this work. The AESO will request the AUC to consider both needs and facilities applications in a combined process.
