The AESO invites all interested stakeholders to attend an Interties Work Shop where industry will explore a fundamental question around the market design of interties in the Alberta market place.

When should interties be treated as internal Alberta generators and loads?

This is a problem of managing seams between the Alberta market place and that of the other North American power markets. This is continuation of the stakeholder consultation on the [Intertie Framework Discussion Paper](#).

The agenda of this work shop will be to examine both scenarios where interties are treated as internal gens/loads versus where they are not. In either case, we will explore what are the market based versus policy driven solutions that manage the issues of restoration, available transfer capability (ATC) allocation and scheduling seams. The objective of the work shop is to explore where there may be common ground within industry on the treatment of interties, or where there may be interim solutions in lieu of a long term design.

This will be the first of two half-day workshops, with the second scheduled for the following Wednesday, June 30th, 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the Metropolitan Center. Stakeholder discussions within the work shop will be without prejudice.
