Subject: BP Canada's comment on the proposed TMR rule

Recognizing that a price reconstituted for TMR pays suppliers more than the market clearing price, BP recommends that the AESO and MSA monitor the rule's effect on offer behaviours and publish the findings within 6 months of implementation. BP also notes that the rule only reconstitutes the price when transmission pulls out-of-merit generation into the energy market but does not reconstitute the price when transmission pushes in-merit generation out of the energy market. The AESO is encouraged to address this glaring inconsistency without delay.
