Re: Dispatch Tool Architectural Upgrade (DTAU) Information Sessions

On June 1, 2010, the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) will begin implementing upgrades to the Dispatch Tool and the Automated Dispatch and Messaging System (ADaMS).

To assist participants with the changes resulting from the DTAU, the AESO recommends that all participants with the ability to enter submissions in the Energy Trading System (ETS) and receive energy market dispatches, ancillary services dispatches and/or ancillary services directives, attend an information session. The information sessions are designed to provide an overview of the changes to ADaMS. The following areas will be covered:

- Key changes to dispatch instructions
- Review of new ADaMS web browser
- Outage information for ETS and ADaMS during cutover
