IRO-003-2 - Reliability Coordination – Wide Area View

Purpose:

SAR, posted for comment.

Current Standards:

IRO-003-2 has been in effect since January 1, 2007.

Proposed Standard:

The purpose of this request is to expand the scope of work for Project 2006-06 Reliability Coordination to address specific directives from FERC Order 693 related to reliability standard IRO-003-2 — Reliability Coordination — Wide-Area View, which have not been assigned to any other project.

The industry need for this request is to ensure that the requirements applicable to the Reliability Coordinator in reliability standard IRO-003-2 — Reliability Coordination — Wide-Area View are clear, measurable, unique and enforceable; and to ensure that this set of requirements is sufficient to maintain reliability of the Bulk Electric System.
