Dear Market Participants and Interested Parties:

Re: Proposed ISO Rules

The Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) is seeking feedback on ISO Rule changes that are being considered for recommendation to the Executive Rules Committee in March 2006.

For your consideration, attached is a draft of the changes to the ISO Rules required to accommodate the recommendations from the Electricity Policy Framework "Quick Hits" Implementation posted on September 21, 2005 and the subsequent Revised Import proposal posted on November 17, 2005. The proposed rules changes are posted in two separate documents. The first document is an abridged version including only the [specific rule changes](#) and the second document is a [complete set of black-lined ISO Rules](#). At this time the documents represent a set of proposed rule changes that are a draft for discussion only.

Given the breadth of the proposed changes the ISO will host a workshop during the week of February 13 to provide clarification and solicit feedback. The comments and feedback received at the workshop will be used to revise the draft ISO Rule package if necessary.

Prior to the start of the public consultation period on February 20, 2006 the ISO will post the revised ISO Rules package to the AESO website. Formal written comments on the revised Rules package are due by March 3, 2006. All comments received will be made public by the AESO.
