Dear Market Participant and other Interested Parties:

Re: Revised Line Outages Information for Keephills 3 System Project and Edmonton Region 240kV Line Upgrades Project (the “Projects”)

The AESO would like to inform all market participants and other interested parties that listings for outages of transmission lines 1203L, 903L and 190L (as part of the Edmonton 240 kV transmission lines upgrade project) previously posted to our Long Term Critical Outage Report are no longer valid due to unforeseen schedule changes for these projects. The outages have been removed from the report and accurate information will be provided when it is available.

Typically, such changes are not accompanied by a letter to our website. However, given the material nature of the projects, the AESO has determined that market participants may find benefit in this additional notification.

The interconnection of the new Keephills 3 generator and the related upgrades to Edmonton area 240 kV transmission lines will require a sequence of line outages over the approximate 18 month construction period of these projects.

Due to the complexity of the project construction schedule and the inherent dependencies within the schedule, the AESO, in keeping with our commitment to open, timely and transparent communication, will provide regular project updates to stakeholders including information regarding transmission line outages and impacts to system operations.
