Dear Market Participants and Interested Parties:

Re: Letter of Notice – Proposed New Level I ISO Rules 10.9 Load Outage Reporting Required to Implement Fair, Efficient and Open Competition Regulation (“FEOC Regulation”)

Pursuant to Section 2(1) of the Alberta Utilities Commission Rule 017, the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) is providing notice and seeking feedback on ISO rule changes that are being considered for recommendation to the AESO Executive Rules Committee (“ERC”) in August 2009.

The new FEOC Regulation under the Electric Utilities Act comes into effect on September 1, 2009. On June 26, 2009, the AESO posted a [Letter of Notice](#) with proposed amendments to ISO rules 1.8 Appointment of an Agent and 1.10 Market Participant Behaviour Guidelines required to implement the FEOC Regulation. The proposed new ISO rule 10.9 deals with the load outage reporting as required by the FEOC Regulation.

After completing consultation with stakeholders on the Transition of Authoritative Document (TOAD) project, the AESO is proceeding with the transition of documents which includes a standard template for ISO rules. New ISO rules such as this ISO rule 10.9 will utilize the standard template and existing ISO rules will be transitioned to the standard template over time.
