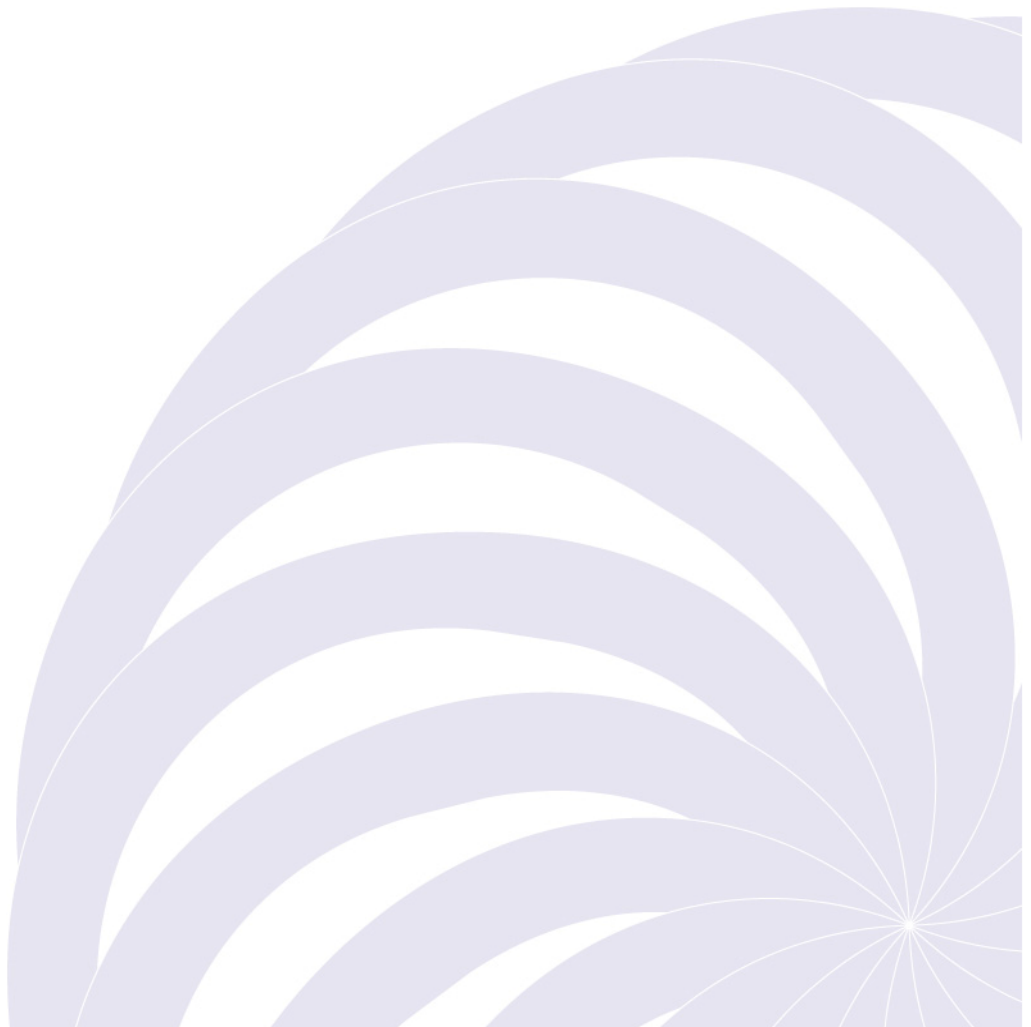

Rule Section/Number	Part 3, OPP 308 WECC Bilateral Inadvertent Energy Payback
Summary of ISO Rule	OPP 308 defines the policies and procedures for the System Controller (SC) in implementing bilateral inadvertent energy payback within the Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC) region.
Reason for Removal	With the implementation of Automatic Time Error Correction in the WECC region, and the Alberta to WECC inadvertent energy accumulation having being reduced to a small balance, the need for bilateral inadvertent energy payback transaction is removed.
