



You're invited... ... We're listening

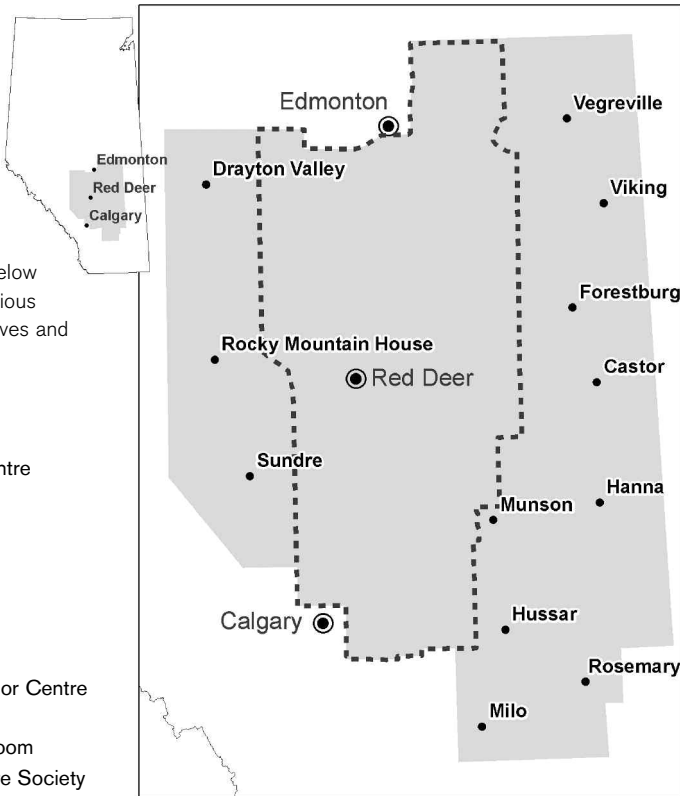
The Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) is meeting with members of the community to provide information and to hear your feedback on the need for reinforcement of the transmission system between the Edmonton and Calgary regions. Construction of a new transmission line between the regions is being considered within the grey study area of the map. We have decided to conduct further study both east and west of the previously outlined study area. The expansion of the study area means more options can be examined. For people who attended prior Open Houses, the materials available will be the same with the exception of the additional geographic concepts east and west of the original study area. None of the concepts within the original area have been eliminated.

After receiving community input, the AESO will identify preferred routing alternatives and file a Needs Identification Document with the Alberta Utilities Commission.

Two transmission facility owners, AltaLink and ATCO Electric, will provide community members information and answers about their operations, and participation in this study.

Please join us at any of the information sessions listed below between 4:00 pm and 8:00 pm. At each Open House, various representatives will be available to show you the alternatives and to listen to your suggestions.
