Re: "Quick Hits" Implementation – Stakeholder Comments

On August 5 the AESO published a set of “term sheets” that were a snapshot of the conversations and discussions being held regarding the implementation of the “Quick Hits” package. On September 21, 2005, the AESO circulated an updated proposal for the implementation of the Quick Hits.

Following the posting of the updated proposal, the AESO held a number of stakeholder sessions where the AESO detailed the current implementation plan for the Quick Hits package.

The stakeholder sessions kicked off the formal stakeholder process regarding the Quick Hits package. The written submissions we have received from 17 stakeholders to date are posted below in their entirety, and we are still waiting on a few submissions.

The comments cover a broad spectrum of topics. We are also preparing two comment matrices. One comment matrix will include all comments that are considered to be within the scope of the Quick Hits consultation. The other comment matrix will include all comments that are out of the scope of the Quick Hits initiative. The AESO will provide written responses to all of the in-scope comments. The comment matrices will be posted to our website as soon as they are completed.

We have reviewed all of the comments that we have received, and there are comments and alternatives that will require additional consideration. We are in the process of preparing written responses to the comments. We are also contemplating drafting a revised set of term sheets. To the extent that there are material changes to the term sheets they will be circulated for comments prior to the issuance of the rules package.
