The AESO adds 12 additional Open Houses

The Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) is meeting with members of the community to provide information and to hear your feedback on the need for reinforcement of the transmission system between the Edmonton and Calgary regions. Construction of a new transmission line between the regions is being considered within the grey study of the map. This area has been expanded as a result of public consultation between May and September of 2008. A second reinforcement is forecast to be needed in the next few years. After receiving community input, the AESO will identify preferred routing alternatives and file a Needs Identification Document with the Alberta Utilities Commission.

Information will be available on options being considered for reinforcement.

Two transmission facility owners, AltaLink and ATCO Electric, have been invited to attend to answer your questions.

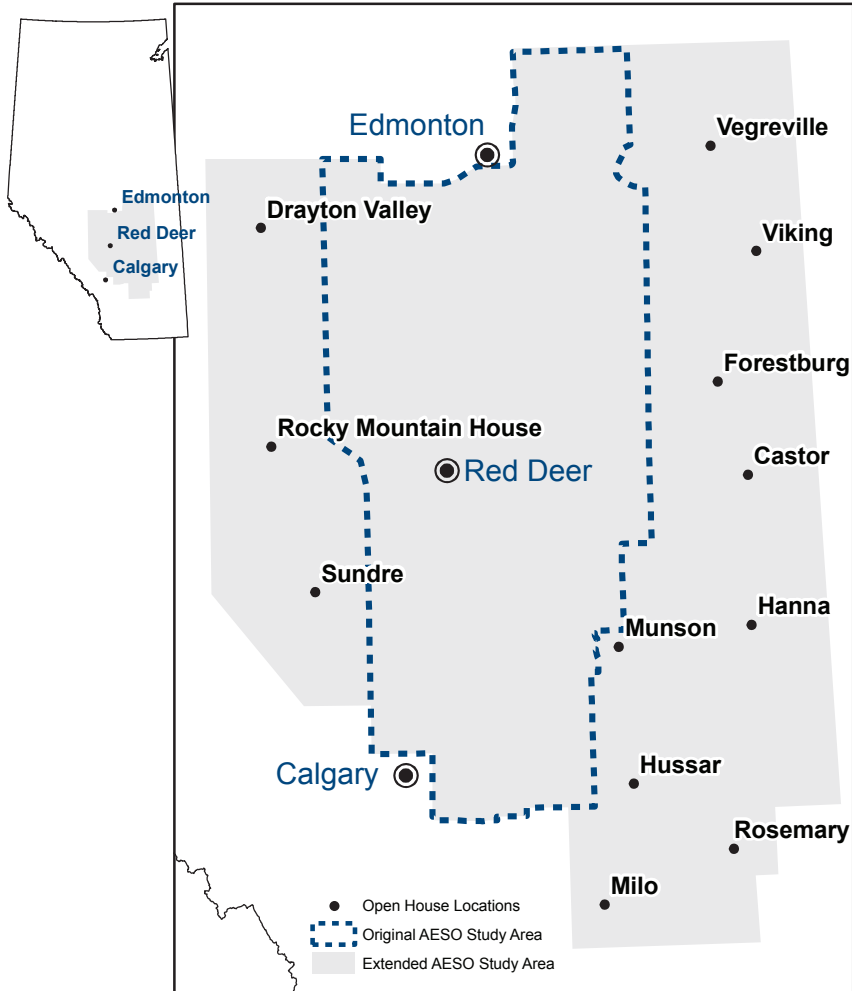
