

Cancellation of the Buffalo Trail North Wind Project Connection in the Dunmore Area

The ENGIE Development Canada LP (ENGIE) request for transmission system access to connect its approved Buffalo Trail North Wind Project (Facility) in the Dunmore area has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) originally approved the AESO's *Buffalo Trail North Wind Project Connection Needs Identification Document* (NID) on April 7, 2022. The NID approval included the following transmission developments:

- Add one 240 kilovolt (kV) transmission line to connect the Facility to the existing 240 kV transmission line 983L in a T-tap configuration.
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission Developments.

NEXT STEPS

The above developments are no longer needed. The AESO intends to apply to the Commission for cancellation of the NID approval.
