## 1 Purpose

This information document relates to the following authoritative document:

- Alberta reliability standard VAR-002-WECC-AB-1, *Automatic Voltage Regulators and Voltage Regulating Systems* (“VAR-002-WECC-AB-1”)

The purpose of this information document is to provide the operator of a generating unit and the operator of an aggregated generating facility with contact information for notifying the appropriate parties at the AESO as required in VAR-002-WECC-AB-1.

## 2 AESO Contact Information for VAR-002-WECC-AB-1

Requirements R1.5 and R1.6 of VAR-002-WECC-AB-1 describe situations where the operator must notify or provide information to the AESO. The relevant contact information is as follows:

- (a) submit the documentation identifying the need for time to obtain replacement parts or the need for time for replacement of the excitation system, as required in requirements R1.5 and R1.6, to [ARSsubmittals@aeso.ca](mailto:ARSsubmittals@aeso.ca); and
- (b) submit requests to schedule an outage, as required by requirements R1.5 and R1.6 to [outage.scheduling@aeso.ca](mailto:outage.scheduling@aeso.ca).
