Re: AESO 2018 ISO Tariff Application - AESO Consultation Invitation

The AESO is considering amendments to its 2018 comprehensive ISO tariff application, which was filed with the Alberta Utilities Commission on September 11, 2017.¹ The AESO invites stakeholders to an information session to discuss the potential amendments to the AESO's application:

At the information session, the AESO intends to present on the following issues, which could result in amendments to the AESO's 2018 comprehensive ISO tariff application:

- Additional consultation for the "12-CP" issue that has occurred since January 19, 2018, as well as additional rate classes potentially including standby, interruptible, or energy storage rates
- Additional consultation for the DFO customer contribution issue that has occurred since January 19, 2018;
- A potential requirement for the earlier execution of system access service agreements for both Rate DTS, *Demand Transmission Service*, and Rate STS, *Supply Transmission Service*;
- Calculation of avoidable construction costs;
- Distribution energy resources and contract levels;
- Point-of-delivery cost curve;
- Treatment of isolated communities seeking to connect interconnected electric system; and
- Peak metered demand waivers.
