Re: **Alberta Electric System Operator (“AESO”) Reply to Stakeholder Comments – Proposed New Section 207.2, Gross Minimum Procurement Volume (“Section 207.2”)**

On November 28, 2018, the AESO issued a [Letter of Notice](#) regarding proposed new Section 207.2 and requesting comments on the same from the Market Surveillance Administrator, market participants, and other interested parties (“stakeholders”). On December 13, 2018, the AESO received stakeholder comments regarding proposed new Section 207.2. On December 20, 2018, in accordance with Section 12.5 of Alberta Utilities Commission (“AUC” or “Commission”) Rule 017, the AESO posted replies to stakeholder comments regarding proposed new Section 207.2.

It has come to the AESO’s attention that, due to inadvertence, the comments submitted by Solas Energy Consulting were omitted from the reply matrix posted on December 20, 2018. Accordingly, the AESO is now posting replies to Solas’ comments regarding proposed new Section 207.2, including the rationale or basis for the position of the AESO that explains why certain positions were rejected or accepted.
