Re: Additional Postings of Revised Proposed New and Amended ISO Rules and Terms and Definitions for the Implementation of the Capacity Market (“Capacity Market Rules and Definitions”)

On January 23, 2019, the AESO posted a [letter](#) advising that the revised proposed new and amended Capacity Market Rules and Definitions were being posted along with blacklines. The AESO advised that certain Capacity Market Rules and Definitions would be posted the following day, January 24, 2019.

On January 24, 2019, the AESO posted the following additional revised Capacity Market Rules and Definitions:

1. Proposed New ISO Rules Terms and Definitions for the Capacity Market;
2. Proposed New, Amended and Removed Energy and Ancillary Services Markets Terms and Definitions; and
3. Section 206.4, *Offers and Bids for Capacity*.

Additionally, the version of Section 201.13, *Capacity Market Clearing* that was posted on January 23, 2019 was replaced with an updated version on January 24, 2019.

On January 25, 2019, the AESO posted the following two additional revised Capacity Market Rules and Definitions:

1. Section 206.3, *Uniform Capacity Value Determination*; and
2. Section 206.8, *Obligation Period Performance Assessments*.

Updates to the consolidated sets have been made to include the above-noted additional revised Capacity Market Rules and Definitions and the associated blacklines.
