

Alberta Reliability Standard Interchange Information INT-001-AB-3

INT-001-AB-3 Interchange Information

1. Purpose

The purpose of this *reliability standard* is to require that *interchange* information is submitted to the *interchange authority*.

2. Applicability

This *reliability* standard applies to:

4. Requirements

- **R1** The ISO must submit to the *interchange authority*, for an *interchange transaction* that sinks in Alberta, the *arranged interchange* in each of the following circumstances:
 - **R1.1** If a *pool participant* is not involved in the *interchange transaction*.
 - **R1.2** If the *interchange transaction* is a bilateral *inadvertent interchange* payback.

5. Processes and Procedures

6. Measures
