

# Need for the Victoria Substation Modification in the City of Edmonton

EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc. (EPCOR) has applied to the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) for transmission system access to reliably serve new demand for electricity in the City Of Edmonton. EPCOR's request can be met by the following solution:

# PROPOSED SOLUTION

 Modify the Victoria substation, including adding two 15 kilovolt circuit breakers and associated equipment.

### NEXT STEPS

- The AESO may approve EPCOR's request for transmission system access under the AESO's abbreviated needs approval process or file a needs identification document (NID) for approval by the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) in late 2016.
- All documents relating to this transmission system access service request will be available on the AESO's website at www.aeso.ca/nid

The following organizations have key roles and responsibilities in providing access to the transmission system:

# > THE AESO:

- Must plan the transmission system and enable access to it for generators and other qualified customers
- Can approve certain requests for system access service through the abbreviated needs approval process. If this project no longer qualifies for approval under this process, the AESO will prepare and submit a NID.
- Is regulated by the AUC and must apply to the AUC for approval of its NID

#### **EPCOR:**

- Is the transmission facility owner in the City of Edmonton
- Is responsible for detailed siting and routing, constructing, operating and maintaining the associated transmission facilities
- Is regulated by the AUC and must apply to the AUC for approval of its transmission facilities applications

Alberta's electric transmission system comprises the towers, wires and related equipment that are a

part of moving electricity from where it is generated to where it is used.
