



## 601 TRANSMISSION OUTAGES AND LIMIT CHANGES

### 3. Policy

#### 3.1 Outage coordination and reliability

- The legal owner of a transmission facility must provide, as soon as reasonable, unplanned derates of any of its transmission facilities and derate information, including the transmission facilities affected, time period, and cause of the derate. The legal owner of a transmission facility must subsequently inform the ISO of plans to restore the derated transmission facilities to their full rating.

#### 4.1 ISO

The ISO must:

- Coordinate delayed forced outage with legal owners to ensure acceptable system risks.

#### 4.2 Legal Owner of a Transmission Facility

The legal owner of a transmission facility must:

- Provide schedules, in electronic form and in the format of [Appendix A](#), to the ISO (e-mail address <mailto:outage.scheduling@aeso.ca> ) as follows:
  - As soon as practical, provide unplanned derates of all transmission facilities to the ISO by telephone. The derate information must include elements affected, time period, and cause of the derate.
