

Project Cancellation for the Grist Lake 190S Substation

FortisAlberta Inc.'s (Fortis) request for transmission system access to connect a new industrial load in the Christina Lake area has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) approved the AESO's *amended Grist Lake 190S Substation Needs Identification Approval Document* (NID) on February 13, 2017. The NID approval included the following transmission developments:

- Add one 138/25 kilovolt (kV) substation, to be designated Grist Lake 190S substation, including adding two 138/25 kV transformers.
- Add two 138 kV transmission lines between the proposed Grist Lake 190S substation and the existing Pike Lake 170S substation.
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.

NEXT STEPS

The AESO intends to apply to the Commission for cancellation of the NID approval in mid-2020.
