

Cancellation of the Whitetail Peaking Station Connection in the Town of Peace River area

The Enbridge Inc. request for system access service to connect the Whitetail Peaking Station (Facility) in the Town of Peace River area has been cancelled.

BACKGROUND

The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) originally approved the AESO's *Whitetail Peaking Station Connection Needs Identification Document* (NID) on July 17, 2015. The NID approval included the following transmission developments:

- Add a 144 kilovolt (kV) transmission line to connect the Facility to the existing 144 kV transmission line 7L106 in a T-tap configuration; and
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.

NEXT STEPS

The above developments are no longer needed. The AESO intends to apply to the Commission for cancellation of the NID approval.
