

# Cancellation for the Coleman 799S Substation Upgrade in the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass area

The FortisAlberta Inc. request for transmission system access to reliably serve new demand for electricity in the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass area has been cancelled.

### **BACKGROUND**

In August 2020, AltaLink began distributing an information package that included the AESO's Need Overview, Coleman 799S Substation Upgrade. The AESO Need Overview included the following transmission developments:

- Upgrade the existing Coleman 799S substation, including replacing one existing 138/25 kilovolt (kV) transformer with a 138/25 kV transformer of higher capacity and adding one 138 kV circuit breaker.
- Add or modify associated equipment as required for the above transmission developments.

## **NEXT STEPS**

The above developments are no longer needed and the AESO will not consider this project under section 501.3 of the ISO rules, *Abbreviated Needs Approval Process*.
