Re: Cancellation - Chapel Rock-to-Pincher Creek Transmission Development

We are writing to inform you that the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) has cancelled the Chapel Rock-to-Pincher Creek (CRPC) Transmission Development.

This decision follows extensive planning, stakeholder engagement, and a reassessment of interest in new electricity generation in the Pincher Creek area. The AESO has determined that the proposed 240 kV transmission circuit and substation are no longer required to meet Alberta's electricity needs.

While AltaLink completed significant preparatory work, including engineering design, land assessments, and consultation with stakeholders, work was paused in 2020. Investment in new generation ultimately did not materialize and, as a result, the AESO has determined there is no longer a need for this transmission system development.
