# MOD-019-AB-0 Forecasts of Interruptible Demands Data

### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this *reliability standard* is to ensure the reporting of actual *interruptible demand* data to allow for the assessment and validation of past events and databases. Forecast *interruptible demand* data is needed to allow for the future *system* assessment to identify the need for *system* reinforcement for continued *reliability*.

## 4. Requirements

R1 The ISO must provide annually to WECC its forecast of interruptible demand data for the next 10 years, as requested by WECC, for summer and winter peak system conditions.
